Rules, Regulations, and Information



Amateur entries are to be cooked using your own recipe, no specific ingredients required (no requirement regarding packaged or fresh ingredients, meat or vegetarian).



You may prepare vegetarian or “meatatarian” chili, or any type you choose , just make your best pot for the competition—and you may be required to taste your own chili.



There are **no electrical outlets available** so it is preferred that you bring your chili hot and ready to serve. Keep your chili hot using a Coleman type camp stove (best choice) or sternos. Absolutely no crock pots!



Each chili entry includes entry for 2 chili cooks/servers. Additional staff will be required to purchase a ticket for admission. Please limit your staffing to 2 people at a time to be considerate of other cooks in the space.



If you have more than one chili entry, we request a separate entry form and fee for each.



Set up time for the chili begins at 8:00am and **must be completed by 10:15 am.** There will be a Cooks’ Meeting at 10:30. If you have any questions, please contact Billie Rogers at the cook off or via phone or email prior. (billie@blowingrock.com).
